
Re. Agatha Burgess

With reference to my conversation with Captain Cowie on 15th May, I enclose a plan No. 146/A/4 and letter from the above dated 5th May, 1956.

2. The position is that when the Railway Company acquired land from Mrs. Agatha Burgess it left a small area between the Railway bed and the sea in her ownership. This small area was not purchased with the bulk of the property for the Francis Patton Playing Field and she now asks for an easement to reach it.

3. As she owned the property at the time of purchase of land by the Railway Company, would you please confirm that she has in fact established her right to cross both the land recently purchased from her and the railway bed, to reach her water-front land.

4. Presumably this right has only been established on foot.
