Sts Indenture

made the eighteenth day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty five between Samuel David Robinson of the Town of Hamilton in the Islands of Bermuda Baker of the one part and Augustus Knight of Sandy's Parish in the said Islands Master of the other part All whereas by an indenture dated the Thirteenth day of September One thousand eight hundred and eighty and assigned to be made between George William Young of Sandy's Parish shew said Master of the one part and said Samuel David Robinson of the other part the said George William Young in consideration of the sum of Forty Pounds paid to him by the said Samuel David Robinson granted conveyed sold aliened and released the hereditaments intended to be hereby granted and conveyed to the use of the said Samuel David Robinson his heirs and assigns subject to a mortgage redemption of the same premises on payment by the said George William Young to the said Samuel David Robinson his heirs and assigns of the sum of Forty Pounds into the said Samuel David Robinson his executor's administration within of the sum of Forty pounds or before the Thirteenth day of September One thousand eight hundred and eighty two and of interest thereon in the meantime at the rate of ten per cent per annum payable half yearly and by the said indenture it was stipulated that in case the said George William Young his heirs executor or administrators should not pay or cause to be paid unto the said Samuel David Robinson his executor's administration within the said sum of Forty pounds on the day therein before named for payment thereon or in case the interest on the said sum should at any time be in arrears and unpaid for the space of three calendar months after the same should become due then it should be lawful for the said Samuel David Robinson his executor or administrators or assigns at any time thereafter without notice to the said George William Young his heirs executor's administration or assigns absolutely to sell and dispose of the said hereditaments either together or in part by public auction to be sold subject to such conditions as he thinks and the conditions thereof and as to all other matters relating to such sale as the
