I am the above named person and I live at the address given with my two daughters. Several months ago I submitted an application to the Commission of Inquiry into Historic Land Loss on behalf of my family.

My mother Marion Lowe, her sisters Cynthia Fishington, Faith Gilbert, Isabelle McMahon, Patricia Williot, and Brother James Darrell are all children of George Wellington Darrell. George Wellington Darrell inherited property in Southampton Parish from Emilius Darrell. I was made aware that there was an application to the land grab commission in reference to the same property on behalf of the Darrell Family (Specifically, the descendant of George Darrell) and I wish to advise that the Commission that Raymond Davis does not represent the children of George Darrell nor has he obtained their consent to submit an application on their behalf.

Additionally, I was provided a copy of an affidavit that was included in Raymond's application to the land grab Commission. Raymond's affidavit makes reference to the Estate of Emilius Darrell. Emilius's Property was inherited by George Darrell, my grandfather. Raymond Davis is not a direct descendant of George Darrell.

My daughter and I have conducted research and I have acquired documents which can prove that George Darrell's property was inherited from his father Emilius Darrell.
