LEMUEL NORMAN TUCKER of Warwick Parish in the Islands of Bermuda, Retired
grocer, hereby revoke all former wills and testamentary dispositions made
by me and declare this to be my last will and testament.

1. I APPOINT my brother Philip Henry Tucker and my daughter Christiana Eunice
Tyrell to be the executor and executrix respectively of this my will
AND I DIRECT said executor and executrix to pay all my just debts funeral
and testamentary expenses as soon as conveniently may be after my decease.

2. I BEQUEATH to my son Lemuel Henry Tucker my two shares in the quality
Bakery, Limited.

3. I BEQUEATH all the rest of my personal estate unto my wife Mabelle
Elizabeth Tucker but should my said wife predecease me then I Bequeath the
same equally between my three daughters Jessie Rosalie Crockwell the said
Christiana Eunice Ophelia Tyrell and Etolle Elizabeth Burch or such of them
as shall be living at the time of my decease share and share alike.

4. I DEVISE all my real estate unto my wife the said Mabelle Elizabeth
Tucker for and during the term of her natural life and from and after her
decease I devise (a) that portion of my property in Warwick Parish designated
as Lot Number One (1) on the plan hereto annexed together with the dwelling-
house or homestead thereon erected to my daughter the said Christiana Eunice
Ophelia Tyrell her heirs and assigns for ever (b) that portion of my said
property in Warwick Parish aforesaid designated as Lot Number Two (2) on the
said plan unto my daughter the said Etolle Elizabeth Burch her heirs and
assigns for ever (c) that portion of my property in Warwick Parish aforesaid
designated as Lot Number Three (3) on the said plan to my daughter the said
Jessie Rosalie Crockwell her heirs and assigns for ever (d) my property in
Sandys Parish in the said Islands together with the building or hall thereon
erected unto my grandson Norman Clifford James Burch in fee simple (e) my
cottage and land in Warwick Parish purchased from Manuel De Costa unto my
three daughters the said Jessie Rosalie Crockwell, Christiana Eunice Ophelia
Tyrell and Etolle Elizabeth Burch in fee simple as tenants in common.

5. I DECLARE that all devises of real estate by this my will shall be con-
strued as being subject to any existing mortgages thereon which said mortgages

are to be assumed and paid by the respective devisees thereof.

6. I DEVISE all the rest residue and remainder of my real estate equally between my said three daughters the said Jessie Rosalie Crockwell Christiana Eunice Ophelia Threll and Stella Elizabeth Burch or to such of them as shall be living at the time of my decease in fee simple as tenants in common.
